**Magnolia Tree Care:** Keep fallen magnolia leaves cleared - they attract moisture-loving pests like sowbugs and millipedes

**Historic Home Alert:** Older Magnolia homes are prone to termite activity - schedule annual inspections

**Garden Protection:** Magnolia's flower gardens attract beneficial insects but also pest predators - maintain balance

**Humidity Control:** Magnolia's humid climate favors roaches and silverfish - use dehumidifiers in basements
